



# Design Development


Refinements to the exterior design based Library review comments.

SCALE


## South Elevation

#### Process:


- Issues related to property ownership can be addressed through existing IGA
- Present plans to Village Board after successful referendum

#### Urban Design:

- Building siting, massing, access and relation to downtown and neighbors are good
- Entry 'plaza' is opportunity to address residential neighbors
- Parking location south of Library is good for its relationship to downtown
- Studies indicate that perceived lack of parking in area is not wholly justified
- Existing residential structures along Route 59 contribute to historic fabric of area
  - Deciding whether to preserve these structures or convert to parking part of post-referendum process

#### Architectural Design:


- Not appropriate to comment on architecture at this stage, but seems a good fit for downtown Plainfield
- Curved glass wall is good association with river
- Add windows to west elevation to enliven street facade
